Eligibility Criteria

1. Nominee must be a member in good standing of FAAR. (REALTOR® or Affiliate)
2. Nominee should have contributed to a program that improves the livability of a local community. Those activities are not limited to real estate or housing issues, and may include such things as crime prevention, youth mentoring, and homelessness prevention.
3. Nominee should have made a significant contribution of personal time, but contributions of money, materials, or other resources will be considered by the Awards Working Group.
4. Nominee will be judged on a level of personal contributions, broadness of impact, and the project's suitability as a role model for other association members.
5. The award is intended to recognize individual contributions, not association-or-company-wide efforts. However, if an individual within a company can be singled out as instrumental to the success of a group effort, he or she is eligible. If the achievements of two people (such as a married couple or co-founders of an organization) absolutely cannot be separated, they can enter as a pair and their entry will be considered as one.
6. Some portion of the nominee's community work must have taken place between October 31, 2011 and October 31, 2012. The Awards Work Group will also consider ongoing efforts outside that timeframe that demonstrate a depth of commitment.
7. This Award may not necessarily be given each year.
8. Nominations must be accompanied by a completed application to be considered.
